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**Report of the Chairperson of the Dormant Accounts Board to the Minister for
Community, Rural and Gaeltacht Affairs as required by the Dormant Accounts
(Amendment) Act 2005 and the Code of Practice for the Governance of State
Bodies**

For the period 4 January– 31 December 2006

Introduction:

This report has been prepared in accordance with Section 10 of the Code of Practice for the Governance of State Bodies. The Dormant Accounts Board is a non-commercial State Board and the format and content of this report has been adapted to reflect that situation. The Board has no executive functions and is purely a policy setting and monitoring entity. In addition, the Dormant Accounts (Amendment) Act 2005, sets out a requirement for the Board, not later than the 30th June each year, to report on the performance of its functions during the previous financial year and include in the report:

- (a) details of the costs and expenses incurred by the Board in performing its functions under this Act,
- (b) details of the results of reviews and assessments under section 31(1)(b) and
- (c) any other information that the Minister may specify

As this is the first Report of the Dormant Accounts Board covering the period from the establishment of the Board on 4th January 2006 to 31st December 2006, this report reviews the activities of the Board since its inception, progress made in the implementation of legislative obligations and functions and an account of financial activities. As well as the statutory reporting requirements met though Appendix A, details of Board membership, attendance at Board meetings and sub-committees are set out in Appendix B. A list of service providers is set out in Appendix C. Chairperson's affirmations are set out in Appendix D and Chairperson's Statement on the System of Internal Financial Control is set out in Appendix E.

The Board, and I as Chairman, are greatly appreciative of the assistance provided by the Department of Community, Rural and Gaeltacht Affairs and the work undertaken by the Secretariat in supporting the work of the Board in a most efficient and professional manner.

Overview of 2006

The Board was established on 4th January 2006 following the enactment of the Dormant Accounts (Amendment) Act 2005.

The functions of the Board are set out in section 31(1) of this legislation and are as follows:

- (a) to prepare and submit to the Minister, in accordance with Section 42, a plan for the disbursement of moneys under Part 6,
- (b) to review and assess from time to time-
 - (i) the extent to which the objectives specified in the plan have been achieved
 - (ii) the effectiveness of the strategies specified in the plan, and
 - (iii) the pattern and effect of disbursements under Part 6, including whether they have resulted in activities that, but for those disbursements, might not have been undertaken.
- (c) to make reports to the Minister under section 45(3).

The Dormant Accounts Act, 2001 together with the Unclaimed Life Assurance Policies Act 2003 and the Dormant Accounts (Amendment) Act 2005 provide a framework for the administration of unclaimed accounts in credit institutions (i.e. banks, building societies and An Post) and unclaimed life assurance policies in insurance undertakings. The main purpose of the legislation is to reunite account holders/policy holders with their funds in credit institutions/insurance undertakings and in this regard, institutions/undertakings are required to take steps to identify and contact the owners of dormant accounts and unclaimed life assurance policies.

Dormant funds/unclaimed life assurance policies, which have not been reclaimed by the original account/policy holder or their beneficiaries, are transferred each year by the financial institution/insurance undertaking to the Dormant Accounts Fund (the Fund) which is managed by the National Treasury Management Agency (NTMA). The transfer of monies takes place on the basis that the beneficial owner will have a guaranteed right of reclaim to their property at any time in the future.

The legislation also introduced a scheme for the disbursement of funds that are unlikely to be reclaimed. Initially the Dormant Accounts Fund Disbursements Board was responsible for overseeing the disbursement of these monies from the Fund. Pursuant to the enactment of the Dormant Accounts (Amendment) Act 2005, decisions on disbursements are now the responsibility of Government. The role of the Dormant Accounts Board is to provide independent advice and to act as a critical appraiser in relation to Government decisions. The Dormant Accounts Board also took over responsibility for disbursement decisions made by the former Dormant Accounts Fund Disbursements Board.

The Board's main activities during 2006 were the preparation of the disbursement plan and putting in place the practical arrangements necessary to provide for the implementation of the plan. A considerable amount of work was also undertaken by

the Board to ensure that the necessary corporate governance structures were developed and implemented.

Main Activities of 2006:

1. Managing approvals by former Board

The Board continued the process started by the previous Board of overseeing the disbursement of monies from the Fund. Pobal continued to administer the first round of funding from dormant accounts. The role of the Board is to monitor the disbursements, approve changes to the projects and decommit approvals where projects elect not to proceed or where they do not fully spend the approved amount.

The Board is responsible for issuing the instruction to National Treasury Management Agency to release moneys from the Fund to Pobal in regard to Round 1 funding. .

2. Developing a new Disbursement Plan

The Board developed a new Disbursement Plan which was approved by the Government on 27th July 2006 and now forms the policy for the second round of project applications and approvals

The plan specifies the objectives to be achieved by making disbursements from the account and the strategies for achieving those objectives, and is prepared in a form and manner in accordance with any guidelines and directions that may be issued by the Minister.

Having regard to its statutory remit, the Board decided in the Plan that disbursements from the Fund should concentrate on projects or programmes designed to assist the following three broad categories of persons:

- Those affected by economic and social disadvantage;
- Those affected by educational disadvantage;
- Persons with a disability.

The plan set out that a target of 40% of total annual funding will be allocated to the area of economic and social disadvantage and at least 25% for each of the other two categories of educational disadvantage and persons with a disability.

The Department of Community, Rural and Gaeltacht Affairs, the Department of Education and Science and the Department of Health and Children respectively administer these.

During the lifetime of the Plan, not less than 50% of annual allocations for economic and social disadvantage purposes shall be disbursed within RAPID, CLÁR, and Local Drugs Task Force areas.

The Disbursement Plan was published in December 2006 and 500 copies were distributed. Copies of the report were sent to 63 Citizens Information Centres, 5 County Enterprise Boards, 109 Educational institutions, 3 Financial institutions, 20 Government Departments, 19 Libraries and 6 Local Authorities, 166 Dáil Deputies and 60 Senators. The remaining 49 copies were sent to Pobal. An electronic copy of the Plan is also available on the Department of Community Rural and Gaeltacht's website.

3. Recruiting economic consultants

The Board decided to recruit economic consultants to undertake a review of the first round of approvals made under the previous Board. The recruitment process began in 2006 and culminated in the appointment of Goodbody Economic Consultants in March 2007.

4. Programme of Audits

The Board maintained a programme of audits to ensure compliance with the Board's Plan and proper governance. In particular, the Board's Audit Committee was active and Deloitte & Touche, who provide an internal audit function to the Board, carried out audits as follows:

- i) In October 2006 Deloitte & Touche submitted a review of an audit of grant payments processed by Pobal from the Dormant Accounts Fund in the period 1 October 2005 to 30 September 2006.
- ii) In October 2006, Deloitte & Touche submitted an update on the monitoring and reporting process carried out by Pobal.

The two audits carried out by Deloitte & Touche produced positive findings and the few areas that merited mention were minor in nature and have been addressed.

During 2006, the Board's Audit Committee reported to the Board on a regular basis in relation to ongoing audit activity. The Chairperson and Board are confident that the systems which have been put in place, while not providing an absolute guarantee against material error, are robust and will ensure monies disbursed from the Fund are expended in accordance with the specific conditions attaching to each disbursement.

4. Corporate Governance and Board Administration

In accordance with the requirements set out in the Code of Practice for the Governance of State Bodies, the Board has approved and adopted a Code of Business Conduct specific to its particular needs. The code sets out a best practice model of corporate governance structures for the Board, including fulfilment of legal, accountability, and other formal management requirements in legislation.

The Board is supported by a small secretariat comprising one member of staff from the Department of Community, Rural and Gaeltacht Affairs. An external adviser (Mr. David Lovegrove, former Secretary to Forfás) was engaged by the Board in February 2006 to support the Board in its work. His role includes advising the Board in relation to the preparation and implementation of the Disbursement Plan and implementation of appropriate governance structures for the Board and Secretariat. The functions of the Secretariat to date have included:

- provision of an effective secretariat to Board meetings;
- assisting the Board in the preparation of the Disbursement Plan;

Appendix C

List of Service Providers in 2006

Transfer/Delegations from the Dormant Accounts Disbursement Board to the Dormant Accounts Board

Section 14 of the Dormant Accounts (Amendment) Act 2005 provides for the preservation of contracts made between the former Board (Dormant Accounts Disbursement Board) and groups/organisations/companies. In this regard, the following service providers were noted by the Board as having a contract with the Board.

- **Legal Advisors**

The former Board appointed Kennedy McGonigle Ballagh Solicitors as legal advisors and received Ministerial approval for the appointment. Kennedy McGonigle Ballagh Solicitors continue under contract with the Dormant Accounts Board.

- **Internal Auditors**

Following a tender process in 2003, the former Board approved the appointment of Deloitte and Touche, Chartered Accountants to provide an internal audit function for the Board and Ministerial approval was obtained for this appointment. Deloitte & Touche continue under contract with the Dormant Accounts Board.

The contract is subject to annual reviews with the option of dispensing with the services of Deloitte and Touche by giving one month's notice in writing.

- **Insurance**

Marsh Ireland Ltd. (insurance brokers) was retained for the management of the Board's insurances. Marsh Ireland Ltd. was retained following a tender process in 2003. Ministerial approval was received for this appointment and Marsh Ireland Ltd. continued to provide this service for the Board

In addition to the above service providers, which were originally retained by the previous Board, the Board retained the services of the following during 2006:

- **Advisor to the Board**

In February 2006 the Board approved the appointment of a suitably qualified person/provider to provide an advisory service to the Board in order to assist it in carrying out its statutory functions. Following a tender process, David Lovegrove of Lovegrove & Associates was awarded the contract for provision of advisory services to the Board. Ministerial approval was received for this appointment.

- **Board Identity**

Red Dog Design Consultants were engaged in 2006 to customise the Board logo and letterhead.

- **Printing**

In 2006 Fodhla Printing was engaged by the Board to design and print the 2005 Annual Report of the Dormant Accounts Fund Disbursement Board and to design and print the Disbursement Plan of the Dormant Accounts Board.

- **Advertisement**

In August 2006, Brindley Advertising Limited was engaged by the Board to place an advertisement in 4 national papers. This advertisement requested expressions of interest from companies to undertake reviews and assessments for the Dormant Accounts Board.

Appendix E

Chairperson's Statement on the System of Internal Financial Control

The Chairperson of the Dormant Accounts Board is responsible for ensuring that the Board's system of internal financial control operates to the highest professional standards. An Audit Committee, which is responsible for overseeing the internal audit function of the Board, has been established comprising three members of the Board. The functions, duties and terms of reference of the Audit Committee have been approved by the Board.

The Board does not have the administrative resources to directly operate the internal audit function and therefore retained external expertise to undertake this role on its behalf. Deloitte & Touche were appointed as internal auditors to the previous Board and have been retained by the current Board. The internal auditors report directly to the Audit Committee through the Chairperson of that Committee.

Deloitte have prepared a Strategic Internal Audit Plan specifying the planned audit activity to be carried out. This Plan was reviewed and approved by the Audit Committee. During 2006, Deloitte continued implementing the plan. However, due to the diminished responsibilities of the Board, the extent of the audit programme has been reduced.

In carrying out its work, the internal auditors include testing of specific areas covered by the Audit Committee's charter to ensure the Board is complying with all requirements. The internal auditors have also reviewed the systems in place in Pobal in relation to their role in the administration of the funding programme.

Given the mandate of the Board, as set out in legislation, which relates to policy setting and monitoring, without any executive functions, the likelihood of financial mis-management is minimal. The Board has adopted the procurement procedures of the Department of Community, Rural and Gaeltacht Affairs. In addition, all payments relating to the Board's activities are processed by the Departments Accounting Section and have to comply with all Departmental procedures.

During 2006, the Audit Committee reported to the Board on a regular basis in relation to ongoing audit activity. The Chairperson and the Board are confident that the systems which have been put in place, while not providing an absolute guarantee against material error, are robust and will ensure monies disbursed from the Fund are expended in accordance with the specific conditions attaching to each disbursement.

Is Bord Stáit neamhthráchtála é an Bord um Chuntais Dhíomhaoine agus tá leagan amach agus ábhar na tuarascála seo curtha in oiriúint chun an seasamh sin a léiriú. Níl feidhmeanna feidhmiúcháin ar bith ag an mBord agus is aonán é chun polasaithe a leagan amach agus chun monatóireacht a dhéanamh ar pholasaithe, agus sin amháin. Bunaíodh an Bord ar an 4ú Eanáir 2006 tar éis achtachán an Achta Um Chuntais Dhíomhaoine (Leasú) 2005.

Leagtar amach feidhmeanna an Bhoird in alt 31(1) den reachtaíocht seo agus is mar seo a leanas atá siad:

- (d) plean eisíocaíochta airgid faoi Chuid 6, a ullmhú agus a chur faoi bhráid an Aire, de réir Alt 42,
- (e) athbhreithniú agus measúnú a dhéanamh ó am go ham-
 - (i) ar a mhéid is a comhlíonadh na cuspóirí atá sonraithe sa phlean
 - (ii) ar éifeachtacht na straitéisí atá sonraithe sa Phlean, agus
 - (iii) ar phatrún agus ar thionchar na n-eisíocaíochtaí faoi Chuid 6, lena n-áirítear a fháil amach ar tharla gníomhaíochtaí nach mbeadh tarlaithe d'uireasa na n-eisíocaíochtaí sin.

Soláthraíonn an tAcht um Chuntais Dhíomhaoine, 2001, chomh maith leis an Acht um Polasaithe Árachais Saoil Neamhéilithe, 2003 agus an tAcht um Chuntais Dhíomhaoine (Leasú) 2005 creat chun na cuntais neamhéilithe in institiúidí creidmheasa (mar shampla bainc, cumainn foirgníochta agus An Post) agus na polasaithe árachais saoil neamhéilithe i ngnóthais árachais a riar. Is é príomhchuspóir na reachtaíochta sealbhóirí cuntas/polasaí a athcheangal lena gcistí in institiúidí creidmheasa/i ngnóthais árachais agus, maidir leis sin, ceanglaítear ar institiúidí/ar ghnóthais céimeanna a ghlacadh chun úinéirí cuntas díomhaoin agus polasaithe árachais saoil neamhéilithe a aithint agus teagmháil a dhéanamh leo.

Aistríonn na hinstitiúidí airgeadais/na ngnóthais árachais cuntais dhíomhaoine/polasaithe árachais saoil neamhéilithe, nach bhfuil athéilithe ag an sealbhóir bunaidh cuntais/polasaí nó ag a dtairbhíthe, gach bliain chuig Ciste na gCuntas Díomhaoin (an Ciste) arna bhainistiú ag Gníomhaireacht Bainistíochta an Chisteáin Náisiúnta. Déantar an t-aistriú airgid ar an mbonn go mbeidh ceart ráthaithe athéilimh ar a mhaoin/ar a maoin ag an úinéir tairbhiúil ag aon tráth sa todhchaí.

Tugadh isteach scéim le haghaidh eisíoc cistí nach móide go n-athéileofar iad, faoin reachtaíocht chomh maith. Ba é Bord Eisíocaíochtaí Chiste na gCuntas Díomhaoin a bhí freagrach i dtús báire as maoirseacht a dhéanamh ar eisíoc an airgid sin as an gCiste. Is é an Rialtas atá freagrach i láthair na huaire as cinntí maidir le heisíocaíochtaí de bhun achtú an Achta Um Chuntais Dhíomhaoine (Leasú) 2005. Is é ról an Bhoird um Chuntais Dhíomhaoine comhairle neamhspleách a thabhairt agus gníomhú mar bhreathmheastóir criticiúil maidir le cinntí an Rialtais. Ghlac an Bord um Chuntais Dhíomhaoine freagracht air féin chomh maith maidir leis na cinntí eisíocaíochta a rinne iarBhord Eisíocaíochta Chiste na gCuntas Díomhaoin.

2. Plean nua Eisíocaíochta a Fhorbairt

D'fhorbair an Bord Plean nua Eisíocaíochta a d'fhaomh an Rialtas ar an 27ú Iúil 2006 agus tá sé in úsáid anois mar pholasaí don dara babhta d'iarratais agus de cheaduithe tionscadail.

Sonraítear sa phlean na cuspóirí a bheidh le baint amach trí eisíocaíochtaí a dhéanamh as an gcuntas agus na straitéisí chun na cuspóirí sin a bhaint amach agus tá an plean ullmhaithe i bhfoirm agus i mbealach a ghabhann de réir treoirlínte agus teoracha ar bith a d'fhéadfadh an tAire a eisiúint.

Déanann an Roinn Gnóthaí Pobail, Tuaithe agus Gaeltachta, An Roinn Oideachais agus Eolaíochta agus an Roinn Sláinte agus Leanaí, faoi seach, iad sin a riar.

Le linn shaolré an Phlean, eisíocfar suim nach lú ná 50% de na leithdháiltí bliantúla i gcomhair míbhuntáiste eacnamaíoch agus sóisialta ar limistéir RAPID, CLÁR agus an Tascfhórsa Áitiúil Ar Dhrugaí.

Foilsíodh an Plean Eisíocaíochta i mí na Nollag 2006 agus scaipeadh 500 cóip.

Seoladh cóipeanna den tuarascáil chuig 63 Ionad Eolais do Shaoránaigh, 5 Bord Fiontair Contae, 109 Foras Oideachais, 3 Foras airgeadais, 20 Roinn Rialtais, 19 Leabharlann agus 6 Údarás Áitiúil, 166 Teachta Dála agus 60 Seanadóir. Seoladh an 49 cóip a bhí fágtha chuig Pobal. Tá cóip leictreonach den Phlean ar fáil

chomh maith ar shuíomh gréasáin na Roinne Gnóthaí Pobail, Tuaithe agus Gaeltachta.

3. Comhairleoirí eacnamaíocha á n-earcú
